What is Stream?


Stream is a service that lets you create, store, share, and view videos securely within your organization.



Add chapters to organize videos into smaller sections.






Integrate Microsoft Teams and Stream

This provides step-by-step instructions on integrating Microsoft Teams and Stream, allowing you to upload recorded videos in Teams to Stream.

INTEGRATE TEAMS AND STREAM

From the left-side menu on the Teams Home page:

- 1. Select the three dots
- 2. A list of apps will display. Select the **Stream** icon.

The Stream page will display. You will have the option to select Upload, Recording, or Playlist.



The Create options in Stream.

- a. Upload: Allows you to add a video or recording that is already saved to your computer to Stream.
- **b. Recording**: Allows you to record a new video.
- c. Playlist: Allows you to create and save a list of videos and recordings that can be grouped together.



Note: You can also create new videos and recordings, including screen recordings, directly from the Stream site itself.
