- Easily integrates with other Microsoft tools







Starting with a blank canvas? From the bottom menu, add inking, notes, reactions, comments, text, and shapes!







Tips and Tricks

If using the inking feature, check out the different options available to you! Choose from different colors, use the highlighter for important points, and even use a laser pointer! And don't worry about messing up, just use the eraser tool! For the notes feature, choose from different colors and use individual or grouped notes!










Have some fun and add reactions to your canvas! And if you want to resize or remove it, just select the reaction and those options will display!




Text and Comments

When adding text, choose the color and style, and then format to your liking!


Just like Word, PowerPoint, and other applications, add comments to your canvas!

Timer and Follow Me
